## Quick Start Guide

- 1** Insert the battery.
- 2** Insert a card.
- 3** Attach the lens. Align the lens's white or red mount index with the camera's mount index of the same color.
- 4** Set the lens focus mode switch to <AF>.
- 5** Set the power switch to <ON>, then set the Mode Dial to <A+> (Scene Intelligent Auto).

- 6** Flip out the LCD monitor.
- 7** Focus on the subject. Aim the viewfinder center over the subject and press the shutter button halfway to autofocus.
- 8** Take the picture. Press the shutter button completely to take the picture.
- 9** Review the picture. The captured image will be displayed for 2 sec. on the LCD monitor.

The ☆ on the right of the function indicates that the function is available only in Creative Zone modes.

### Picture Style ☆

- Press the <Down> <Up> button.
- Press the <Left> <Right> keys to select a Picture Style, then press <SET>.

Style	Description
Auto	Color tones optimized for the particular scene.
Standard	Vivid colors and sharp images.
Portrait	Nice skin tones and slightly sharp images.
Landscapes	Vivid blue skies and greenery and very sharp images.
Monochrome	Black-and-white images.

- For <Auto> (Neutral) and <Standard> (Faithful), refer to the Camera Instruction Manual.


## Using the Built-in Flash

### Basic Zone Modes


If necessary, the built-in flash will be automatically raised and fired in low-light or backlit conditions (with certain shooting modes).

### Creative Zone Modes

- Press the  $\llcorner$  button to raise the built-in flash, then shoot.



## Creative Zone Modes



### P: Program AE

- Set the Mode Dial to <P>.
- The camera automatically sets the shutter speed and aperture in the same way as the <A+> mode.

### Tv: Shutter-priority AE

- Set the Mode Dial to <Tv>.
- Turn the  $\llcorner$  dial to set the desired shutter speed, then focus on the subject.
- The aperture will be set automatically.
- If the aperture display blinks, turn the  $\llcorner$  dial until it stops blinking.


### Av: Aperture-priority AE

- Set the Mode Dial to <Av>.
- Turn the  $\llcorner$  dial to set the desired aperture, then focus on the subject.
- The shutter speed will be set automatically.
- If the shutter speed display blinks, turn the  $\llcorner$  dial until it stops blinking.

## ISO: ISO Speed ☆




- Press the <ISO> button.
- Press the  $\llcorner$  or  $\llcorner$  keys or turn the  $\llcorner$  dial to select the desired ISO speed, then press <SET>.
- When [AUTO] is selected, the ISO speed is set automatically. When you press the shutter button halfway, the ISO speed setting is displayed.



## Drive Mode




- Press the  $\llcorner$  button, press the  $\llcorner$  or  $\llcorner$  keys to select the drive mode, then press <SET>.
- Single shooting
- Continuous shooting
- Silent single shooting
- Silent continuous shooting
- 10-sec. self-timer/remote control
- Self-timer: 2 sec.
- Self-timer: Continuous



## AF: AF Operation ☆




- Set the lens focus mode switch to <AF>.
- Press the  $\llcorner$  AF> button, press the  $\llcorner$  or  $\llcorner$  keys to select the AF operation, then press <SET>.




- ONE SHOT (One-Shot AF):** For still subjects
- AI FOCUS (AI Focus AF):** Switches the AF operation automatically
- AI SERVO (AI Servo AF):** For moving subjects


## AF Point Selection ☆



- Press the  $\llcorner$  or  $\llcorner$  button.
- You can shift the AF point horizontally by turning the  $\llcorner$  dial, and vertically by turning the  $\llcorner$  dial while holding down the <Av> button. If you press <SET> straight down, the center AF point (or center zone) will be selected.



## AF Area Selection Mode ☆




- Press the  $\llcorner$  or  $\llcorner$  button.
- Look through the viewfinder and press the  $\llcorner$  button.
- Each time you press the  $\llcorner$  button, the AF area selection mode changes.

## Live View Shooting



- Press the  $\llcorner$  button to display the Live View image.




- Press the shutter button halfway to focus, then press it completely to take the picture.

## Number of Possible Shots (Live View Shooting)

Temperature	No Flash	50% Flash Use
At 23°C / 73°F	Approx. 200 shots	Approx. 180 shots


## Movie Shooting (Autoexposure)



- Set the power switch to <M>.
- Set the Mode Dial to any shooting mode except <M>.



- Press the  $\llcorner$  button to start shooting a movie.
- To stop movie shooting, press the  $\llcorner$  button again.



## Built-in microphones

- When the shooting mode is <M>, you can shoot movies with manual exposure.
- You can set movie shooting settings with the menu options under the [1] or [2] tab.
